## NOTICE

All participants of the Easter Invitational Grand Prix are hereby notified that Doping Controls will be in effect for this event.

All samples will be collected in accordance with the International Standards for Sample Collection under the WADA Code effective January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2016.

## **YOUR RIGHTS**

If selected you have the right to:

- ✓ have someone (coach, medical personnel etc.) accompany you for the procedure (however they will not witness the passing of the urine). Having a witness is mandatory for anyone under the age of 18 or a person with a disability.
- ✓ request to see the identification of the notifying officer (Chaperone)
- ✓ request time to cool down or attend a media activity. However the notifying officer (Chaperone) must be in attendance at all times and you must be in full sight at all times. In such instances you must report to the doping control station within 30 minutes of being notified. Any perceived attempt to lose or shake the chaperone can be considered a doping rule violation.

## YOUR RESPONSIBILITIES

If selected you have the responsibility to:

- ✓ bring along identification (national ID preferable)
- ✓ report to the doping control station at earliest point once notified
- ✓ ensure that liquids provided at the doping control station are properly sealed before opening
- ✓ comply with the instructions of the doping control team for the duration of the process
- ✓ maintain possession of sample collection vessels and urine sample at all times prior to securing in the selected container
- ✓ provide list of any medication, supplements, vitamins etc. currently being used
- ✓ provide the Doping Control Officer (DCO) with a copy of any Therapeutic Use Exemptions (TUE's)
- ✓ review Doping Control form before signing to ensure all information is accurate and that the numbers registered match those of the sample collection container
- ✓ collect copy of Doping Control form as evidence of the process
- ✓ keep your copy safe *No News is Good News!*
