



BIB NUMBERS

1. Bib numbers are to be secured to cyclists' LEFT AND RIGHT HAND SIDE
2. Only TTCF issued Bib Numbers will be allowed. Any cyclist found using unauthorised numbers can be disqualified and/or fined
3. Bib numbers are to be properly secured. That is, cyclists are to ensure that numbers are not loose or incorrectly positioned

EQUIPMENT SAFETY

1. Team Managers are responsible for ensuring that all equipment used by their cyclists are safe for use. All helmets must be properly secured etc

HOLDING BAY

1. Cyclists are required to be in the Holding Bay no less than 5 minutes before the start of their event. Any cyclist who is not in the holding bay when their race is called to the line will not be permitted to start.

UNIFORM

1. Clubs are reminded that there should only be ONE design to the club's uniforms. Team Managers and Clubs are hereby reminded that cyclists who appear from the same club but with different design uniforms will not be allowed to compete.

500M HEATS

1. Team Managers are required to confirm their cyclists' participation in the 500m Heats with the Racing Secretary by 4:45pm on Race Day. Any cyclist who was not confirmed by this time will be removed from the Start List and will not be allowed to start the event.
